- You have access to the only Proprietary Military Occupational Skills Translator in the US.
- The Hiring Portal is the only non-governmental touch point with exiting service members as they out-process the service through DoD's mandatory Transition Assistance Program. You have access to service members as soon as they are out of service.

About the Bob Woodruff Foundation

The Bob Woodruff Foundation was founded by ABC News reporter Bob Woodruff and his family after Bob was wounded by a roadside bomb while covering the war in Iraq. The Foundation funds proven organizations delivering services to veterans, service members and their families in all 50 states. Bob Woodruff Foundation's Got Your 6 Network of 400 boots-on-the-ground partner organizations provides physical and mental health care, housing and legal assistance, disaster relief, and job placement services to the military community. The Foundation has funded \$189 million in proven veteran programs and services since it opened its doors in 2006. More than two million Americans in the military community receive care or support from a Got Your 6 Network partner each year, building on the Foundation's commitment to always have the backs of those who have served.

Critical Issues

We understand that some of the military community's greatest challenges—mental health and wellbeing, legal and employment obstacles, housing and food insecurity—are interconnected and require an integrated approach.

We invest in programs that acknowledge the connectedness of issues: a person's housing status will affect their ability to secure a job, or feeding yourself is made harder when struggling with your mental health, for example.
